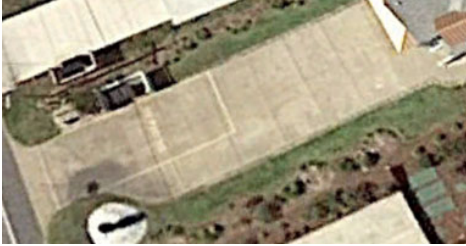


Arabella Trash, Parking & Recycling

Yes, trash and parking are related.

Trash pickups: early AM Monday & Thursday: Trash goes into the dumpster beside the parking area. Twice a week, on collection mornings, a city trash truck gets beside the dumpster and lifts it up above the truck with an automated hoist to empty it. The truck and hoist combo is huge – taking up all the space marked by the “No Parking” box. Here’s an aerial view of the dumpster and the “No Parking” box.



Parking: The truck that empties the dumpster is the connection to the parking. The “No Parking” box needs to be free Sunday night for the Monday AM pickup and Wednesday night for the Thursday AM pickup so the trash truck can get in.



So “No Parking” only applies Sunday overnight and Wednesday overnight. Other than that, park there as you like.

Recycling: The nearest center (1.2 miles away) is the Kill Devil Hills Recycling Center at 701 Bermuda Bay Blvd here in KDH. Drop off hours as of February 2023 are Monday thru Friday 8AM- 4PM, and Saturday 8AM -2PM. Unfortunately, the center is not open on Sundays when you leave Arabella, so dropping off recyclables as you drive around during the week is recommended.

OPEN TO ALL | NO DTDO DECAL REQUIRED

GLASS

- Rinsed Green, Clear, Brown Bottles/Jars [no lids]
- Mirrors without Frames
- Crystal
- Ovenware
- Standard Non-Flourescent Light Bulbs [unbroken]
- no sorting required

PLASTICS, ALUMINUM BEVERAGE CANS, STEEL FOOD CANS [NO PLASTIC BAGS]

- Aluminum Drink Cans [rinsed]
- Only Steel Food Cans [rinsed]
- Plastic Bottles, Jugs: Soda, Milk, Juice, Water, Detergent, Shampoo, etc. [rinse & look for #1-7 on bottom of each container]
- NO aerosol cans

MIXED PAPER

- Newspaper
- Office Paper, Mail
- Paperboard, Shoeboxes, Cereal Boxes
- Magazines, Catalogs, Phone Books
- Paper Bags, etc.
- NO plastic bags or wet/dirty/food contaminated paper

CARDBOARD

- Dry, Flattened, Corrugated

OYSTER SHELLS

- Place in Yellow Cans Onsite

USED COOKING OIL

- Place in Original Container [no filtering necessary]

FROM RESIDENTIAL SOURCES ONLY

Maximum 5 Gallons Per Visit
Do Not Mix Any of the Following with Any Other Chemical or Material:

USED OIL, ANTIFREEZE

- Transmission Fluid, Power Steering Fluid, Hydraulic Fluid
- Kerosene, Fuel Oil, Diesel Fuel
- bring filter too
- NO brake fluid, see attendant

WASTE FUEL

- Gasoline, Two-Cycle Gasoline
- see attendant

BATTERIES

- Lead Acid Automotive, Marine, Mower, Other Vehicle
- Rechargeable Batteries
- NO single use alkaline batteries

SMALL PROPANE TANKS

- For Typical Outdoor Grills

SCRAP METALS & WHITE GOODS

- Stoves, Washers, Dryers
- Water Heaters, Air Conditioners, Freezers
- Metal Pipes, Metal Siding
- Tools, Lawn Mowers
- do not crush appliances with freon
- remove gas tank from motors & drain crankcase
- NO crab pots, wire fencing, or sealed containers

HAZARDOUS WASTE NOT ACCEPTED

- Asbestos
- Cleaning Supplies
- Lawn Chemicals
- Oil-Based Paints & Stains
- Pesticides

MULCH & COMPOST

- Residents of Kill Devil Hills can self-serve mulch and compost as available
- not for commercial use
